GPs can now prescribe a falls package that includes Lifeline and a fall detector that automatically alerts a 24-hour helpline if there is a fall or if someone presses for help.

1

GP determines if the patient is at risk of falling. This is the only criteria and at the sole discretion of the GP.

Complete the attached form and fax to Riverside Housing on 0151 295 6474. Alternatively, print the form from the EMIS site and fax to the number above.

Once the form is received, Riverside will email the GP Practice from their NHS net account to confirm receipt and the actions taken.
